What are Teachers College (TC) Clubs? How many clubs can my child take?

In 2016-2017, Teachers College is organizing after school enrichment clubs for students in grades K to 5 in partnership with HYPOTHEkids and the 92nd Street Y. The following clubs are available for each grade level:

Kindergarten: Engineering Is Elementary, Nutrition

1st grade: Engineering Is Elementary, Nutrition

2nd grade: Robotics, Wellness, Music, Crazy 8s, Chess

3rd grade: Robotics, Wellness, Music, Crazy 8s, Chess, Funny Girls

4th grade: Choir, Orchestra, Makers Club, Crazy 8s, Chess, Funny Girls

5th grade: Choir, Orchestra, Games

Each club can accommodate up to 15 students and participation is free (except for activity fees for orchestra). Students may sign up for up to two clubs per week. Use the enclosed enrollment form to sign up.

When are TC Clubs available?

TC Clubs will run from September 26, 2016 to December 21, 2016 and begin again on January 18, 2017 to May 19, 2017. Clubs start at 2:55pm and dismissal is at 4:50pm. Early dismissal is available only with advance notice to the TC Clubs coordinator. Parents must pick up their children no later than 5pm unless they are also signed up for the Roads to Success program on that day, in which case they dismiss at 6pm.

What will my child's schedule look like?

Most TC Clubs last 50 minutes. On a typical day, students enrolled in TC Clubs spend 25 minutes in the cafeteria for snack, another 25 minutes in the gym for a movement activity, and 50 minutes in the classroom, for their respective clubs. Some clubs require students to participate for 80 minutes of instruction, allowing another 25 minutes for snack. Students may only take one club per day.

What are my options if I need after school care on days/at times when TC Clubs are not available?

Parents have the option to also enroll their children in the after school program provided by Roads to Success throughout the year in addition to participating in TC Clubs. However, the Roads to Success program will not be discounted for students enrolled in TC clubs on the same day. Prices for Roads to Success program options (3, 4 or 5 days/week) are included in the Roads to Success materials.

Parents whose children are only enrolled in TC Clubs have the option to sign them up for the Roads to Success program between January 3 and 17, and May 22 to June 23 (please consult the Roads to Success brochure for details).

When and how do I enroll my child(ren) in TC Clubs?

The PRIORITY DEADLINE for enrollment in TC Clubs is Monday, July 25. The FINAL DEADLINE is Thursday, September 15. Parents /guardians who sign up by July 25 will receive confirmation of the Clubs in which their children are enrolled by August 10. Parents/guardians who sign up after July 25 will receive confirmation of their children's Club schedule in September.

ENRICHMENT CLUBS AT A GLANCE

Chess (offered by HYPOTHEkids in collaboration with the Kasparov Chess Foundation) – GRADES 2, 3 & 4

Students enrolled in the Crazy 8s math club are encouraged to sign up for chess. Chess builds focus, concentration, analytical and critical thinking skills which are all extremely important in math problem solving. HYPOTHEkids is partnering with the Kasparov Chess Foundation (<http://kasparovchessfoundation.org/>) to bring our HYPOTHEkids Mathcrush Club members two days of Chess. (Students must be in Crazy 8s to sign up for Chess. Chess meets twice a week—on Mondays and Fridays—and attendance is mandatory for both sessions.

Choir (offered by TC) – GRADES 4 & 5

Taught by a TC graduate student with several years of experience as a choir leader and cantor, the club will focus on building musical skills for students to be lifelong learners and advocates of music. Students will be exposed to various musical genres and styles. They will move to the beat and sing songs in foreign languages. Choir will have the opportunity to represent TCCS during in-school and out of school performances. Warm-up those voices and sing “Do, Re Mi...”

Crazy 8s (offered by HYPOTHEkids) – GRADES 2, 3 & 4

Math is the cool thing to do after school. Crazy 8s is designed to get kids fired up about math. Every week Crazy 8ers will build stuff, run and jump, make music, make a mess... all while bonding with friends over math.

Engineering Is Elementary (offered by TC) – GRADES K & 1

Get ready for another great year of Engineering Is Elementary! Led by Jason Wu, PhD candidate in TC's Science Education program, the EiE Club focus on three core areas: having fun, learning authentic science, and building character. Through hands-on activities and projects, students learn the fundamentals of engineering and the natural sciences. The curriculum covers diverse topics from the physics of sound to the basics of cells, and will culminate in an engineering/building project.

Funny Girls (offered by HYPOTHEkids in collaboration with The Harnisch Foundation) – GRADES 3 & 4

Does your daughter crave an activity where she can creatively express her brain and brawn while expanding her leadership skills? HYPOTHEkids is partnering with Funny Girls (<http://thehf.org/project/hf-funny-girls/>), an afterschool class exploring leadership skills taught through improv. Improv, a form of theater game, encourages participants to create characters and plot on the spot while supporting each other. Practicing leadership skills including self-awareness, learning agility, collaboration, empathy, and resiliency, the class will encourage girls to creatively problem solve in any situation. Throughout the 10-week curriculum, girls will cultivate confidence in their individual choices. Girls will be on their feet, expanding their imagination, taking bold risks, and having FUN! (This program will only run in the fall and students must be part of Crazy 8s to participate. Students cannot be both in Chess and Funny Girls.

Games (offered by TC) – GRADE 5

A graduate student from TC's Communications, Media, and Learning Technologies Design program will lead a gaming club for students in fifth grade. Each week, students will play games (digital or otherwise) that promote active learning, problem solving, strategic thinking, teamwork, and creativity.

Makers Club (offered by TC) – GRADE 4

Do you like to invent new tools or machines? Do you like to doodle or sew? Do you enjoy making things for other people? In the TCCS After-school Makers Club, hosted by the Snow Day Learning Lab (snowdaylearning.org) from Teachers College, you will use a variety of hand tools, craft materials, conductive inks and threads, sewable computer chips, and even some high tech equipment such as laser cutters and 3D printers to imagine, design, and build new toys for younger kids in your school and community! The toys might be a pop-up book with lights and sounds, a story book that talks, a motorized car, a stuffed animal that responds when hugged, or anything else you can dream up! The TCCS After-school Makers Club is part of a research study being conducted to improve the design of maker activities and we'd love to have you be part of it! Music (offered by the 92nd Street Y) – GRADES 2 & 3

The 92nd Street Y is back for another year at TCCS! Students in 92nd Street Y will study music from different countries to expose them to different cultures around the globe. Students will learn how to sing music of foreign lands and play musical instruments. They will also observe seasonal concerts throughout the year at the 92nd Street Y. Students will culminate their experience with the 92nd Street Y. with an end of year performance in May.

Nutrition (offered by TC) – GRADES K & 1

Led by a student enrolled in the Nutrition program at TC, the club will introduce children to healthy eating principles and allow them to cook fun and easy recipes. The aim of the program is to instill an appreciation of wholesome foods and life-long health habits in our students.

Orchestra (offered by TC) – GRADES 4 & 5

Students participating in the orchestra program will learn mastery of one stringed instrument (violin, viola, cello, or bass). Orchestra is a rigorous program that provides students an opportunity for growth in musical playing and also develops skills through teamwork. Orchestra includes a mentorship component, whereby students from the Nyack High School Chamber Orchestra will assist and train members of the TCCS orchestra in their musical development. Due to the rigor of the program, students are REQUIRED to practice at home every week on a computer program (Smart Music). All rehearsals and concerts are MANDATORY. Orchestra meets twice a week on Mondays and Wednesdays. Failure to meet any of the requirements above will result in termination. Course-related fees apply. Students participating in orchestra may not enroll in other clubs.

Robotics (offered by TC) – GRADES 2 & 3

Students from TC's Institute of Learning Technologies (ILT) have taught robotics and introductory coding to TCCS students in past years. They are pleased to continue to introduce robotics using the LEGO WeDo kit/Virtual Robots and Programming software. With robotics at the center of instruction, ILT students will also teach basic programming as a means for TCCS students to work with real-life and virtual robots. Thus, students participating in the Robotics Club will not only learn how to build LEGO robots, they will acquire problem solving and sequencing skills and use their creativity to bring their robots to life.

Wellness (offered by TC) – GRADES 2 & 3

The Wellness class at TCCS will empower students to learn about the importance of health and wellness in their everyday lives. Students will learn the power of movement, mindfulness, and being in tune with the world around them. Students will practice Zumba, yoga and meditation. They will learn ways to cope with stress and anxiety and learn how to effectively communicate their feelings in healthy and productive ways!
